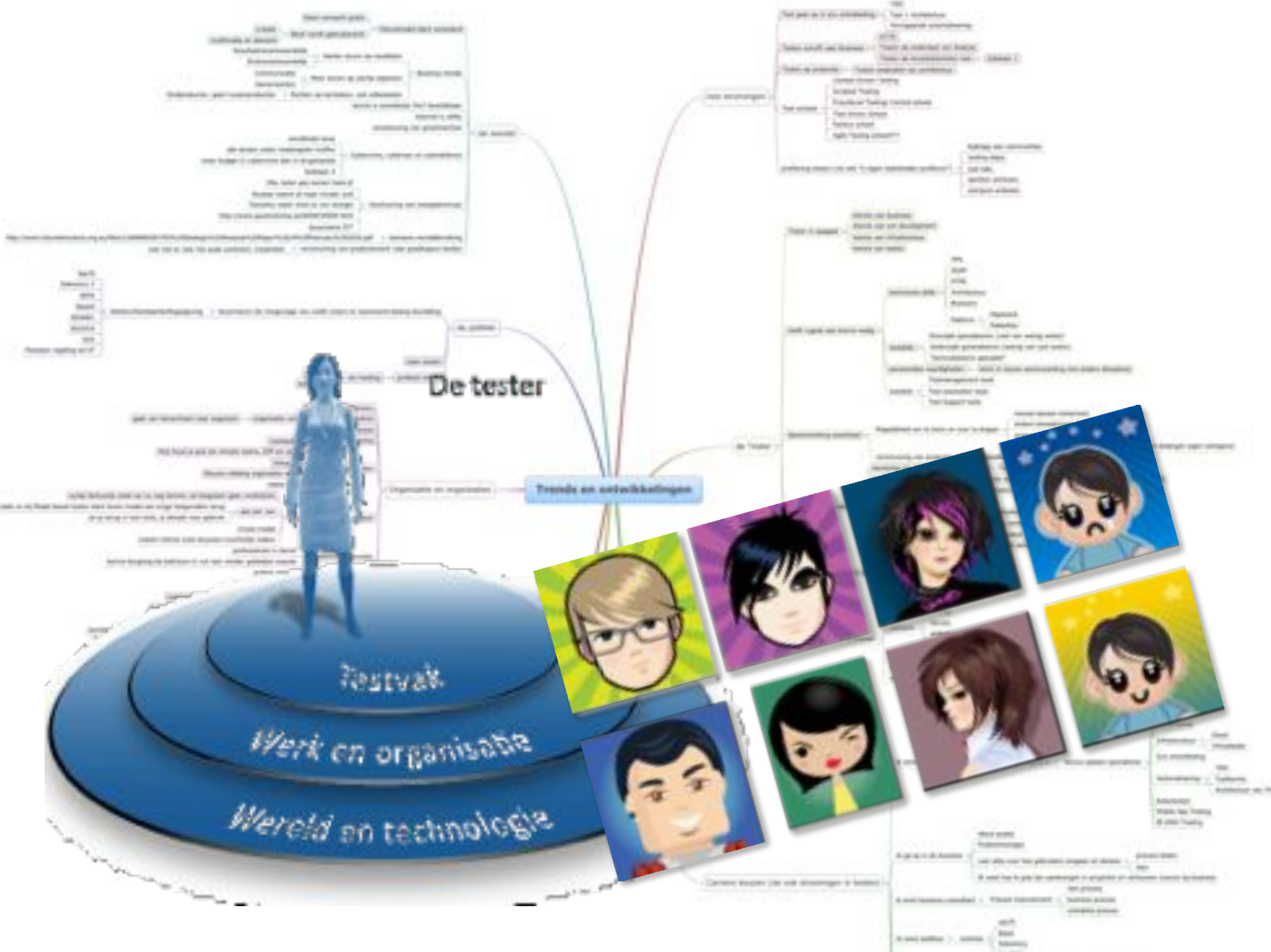

 Subject: The Future of Software Testing

I saw the future of software testing back in 2000 when I read Kent Beck's Extreme Programming Explained. The entire development team takes responsibility for delivering a software product of highest possible quality. They start by writing tests, even before they write code.

Back in 2003, my team committed to delivering the best software we possibly could. We learned to slice our features into tiny increments, and work in tiny test/code/test/code/test iterations each increment is done and we can show it to our customers. We automate all regression tests do exploratory testing. Extremely short feedback loops allow fast course corrections.

For eight years we've used retrospectives to identify impediments, and think of small experiments to overcome them. We've invested a lot of time in learning to manage our technical debt, and regression tests, and shorten our feedback loop. We've collaborated closely with our customers to become domain experts ourselves.

Not everyone on the team could make the transition. We learned that you need the right people that you need to give them plenty of time to continually learn and improve. We learned it is possible even when starting with a huge burden of bad legacy code and technical debt.

I hope our team is an example of the future of software testing. Bring everyone into the team, working together towards the same goals. Focus on quality, not speed.
